

FACTS**WHAT DOES MAZDA FINANCIAL SERVICES (“MFS”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. The information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and income ■ account balances and payment history ■ transaction or loss history and credit scores
How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information, the reasons MFS chooses to share, and whether you can limit sharing.

What we do	
How does MFS protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does MFS collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ give us your contact information ■ apply for financing or apply for a lease ■ pay your bills or provide account information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business information-information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See the section below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our affiliates include financial companies with a Toyota or Lexus name, such as Toyota Financial Savings Bank, Toyota Credit de Puerto Rico Corp, and Toyota Financial Services Corporation; and nonfinancial companies, such as Toyota Motor Insurance Services, Inc. and Toyota Motor Corporation.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Mazda Motor of America, Inc. d/b/a Mazda North American Operations</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our joint marketing partners include authorized Mazda dealerships and other Mazda dealerships with which we have a business relationship.</i>
Other important information	
<p>For California Residents: We will not share your personal information, except as permitted by California law. Please see the enclosed notice "Important Privacy Choices for Consumers" as you may have additional rights and choices regarding your personal information under California law.</p> <p>For Vermont Residents: We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to our affiliates. We will not disclose your personal information to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
