





BEFORE YOUR RETURN

- O Examine possible excessive wear and use on your vehicle and make any necessary repairs*.
- O Your originating Dealer is required to accept your return vehicle. If you are unable to return to your original dealer, contact your local Mazda dealer to schedule a turn-in appointment.
- O Ensure all contracted payments and miscellaneous fees are paid to MFS.
- O Call your local DMV to find out if your state requires license plates to be returned at lease-end.

DURING YOUR RETURN

Bring the following to your lease-return appointment:



O Toolkit and spare tire, if applicable.



O All sets of keys (masters/remotes/valet), if applicable.



O Owner's Manuals.

O Any original equipment on your vehicle at lease inception (radio, headrests, third-row seat, tonneau/cargo cover, etc.).

O Ask the dealer to record the mileage, and don't forget to sign the Odometer Disclosure Statement and ask for a copy.

AT THE DEALERSHIP

- O Confirm the Dealership will accept the return.
- O Sign an odometer statement and ask for a copy for your records. Capture the name of the Dealer associate that helped with the return.

RETURNING YOUR VEHICLE AT LEASE-END

AFTER RETURN

O MFS will send you a Lease-End Invoice if you have any unpaid payments, late fees, and miscellaneous charges*.

The Invoice will also include Excessive Wear and Use charges, Excessive Mileage charges, and Disposition Fee, if applicable. These items may be taxable.

- O Immediately cancel any electronic payments you may have set up.
- O If you have a security deposit, it will be applied to any Lease-End Invoice charges, if applicable. If there are no charges, your security deposit will be returned to your home address via check.
